All destinations are wheelchair accessible unless indicated otherwise. **Please notify us when registering if you use a wheelchair or other mobility aid.** Departure and return times may be adjusted due to certain circumstances beyond our control. Please register early as seating is on first come, first served basis. ## Reagan Library

The Reagan Library is one of California's most beautiful and unique destinations. The Library, under the authority of the Presidential Records Act, is the repository of presidential records for President Reagan's administration. Its holdings include over 60 million pages of documents, over 1.6 million photographs, a half million feet of motion picture film, tens of thousands of audio and video tape, and over 40,000 artifacts. Exhibits include a full-size replica of the Oval Office, the actual Air Force One aircraft, which flew seven U.S. presidents, and the Memorial Site of President Ronald Reagan. You'll also get to tour a special exhibition of Titanic at the Reagan Library, a fascinating look at the Titanic, combining real artifacts with the real stories of the people onboard the ill-fated ship. This new exhibit tells the story of the ship in a way no museum has done before. Artifacts from passengers, dispersed over time, will be reunited in this exhibit for the first time in over 100 years. There are two restaurants available on site (on your own). Please arrive at 8:30 a.m. for check in. The bus will leave promptly at 9:00 a.m. An adult must accompany children of all ages.
