Trip registration is through the Recreation and Community Services Department at Lakewood City Hall. **All trips depart from the Burns Community Center, 5510 Clark Ave. in Lakewood unless otherwise noted.** Participant parking is available in the southeast parking lot of Burns. All destinations are wheelchair accessible unless indicated otherwise. **Please notify us when registering if you use a wheelchair or other mobility aid.** Departure and return times may be adjusted due to certain circumstances beyond our control. Please register early as seating is on a first come, first served basis. Registration is non-transferable. TRAVEL REFUNDS

Reagan Library

Perched atop a hill with sweeping views of the southland, the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library is one of California's most beautiful and unique destinations. A new technologically advanced three-dimensional holographic image of President Reagan will set the stage for your museum experience, where you can walk onboard the actual Air Force One aircraft which flew seven U.S. presidents, view a full-size replica of the White House Oval Office, examine an actual section of the Berlin Wall, and more. Included in this self-guided tour is Pompeii: The Exhibition, featuring over 150 authentic artifacts on loan from the renowned Naples National Archaeological Museum in Italy. These are not replicas, but rather original, 2,000-year-old objects that were preserved in the volcanic ash from the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D. These artifacts include wall-sized frescos, marble and bronze sculptures, jewelry, ancient Roman coins, and full body casts of the volcano's victims. A celebration of Southern California's culture and community, the fair offers visitors 800 unique vendor booths with everything from arts & crafts, antiques, clothing, jewelry, home décor, plants and more. An international food court features more than 50 booths serving all types of cuisine plus a beverage garden.
