



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING


ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 2022-1 TO THE GENERAL PLAN PERTAINING TO THE HOUSING ELEMENT AND RELATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Lakewood City Council on the adoption of the proposed 2021-2029 Housing Element of the General Plan of the City of Lakewood. The Housing Element is a required element within the City's General Plan, and must be updated according to State law. The Housing Element discusses a number of key State mandates including identifying the City's housing needs, describing the available resources to meet the needs, identifying programs to provide and preserve affordable housing, identifying housing assistance programs and affirmatively furthering fair housing for Lakewood residents. Said proposal does not affect any specific property within the City of Lakewood and has a general citywide effect. The negative declaration for this project shall also be considered at the hearing.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that said public hearing will be held on TUESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2022, AT 7:30 P.M. in the City Council Chambers at the Civic Center, 5000 Clark Avenue, Lakewood, California. All interested persons may appear at that time and testify in this matter. The proposed Housing Element and draft Negative Declaration are available for review in the Community Development Department of Lakewood City Hall, 5050 Clark Avenue, Lakewood.
