



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Beginning in 2022, Lakewood City Council Members will be elected based on districts, each representing a portion of the city, instead of having each council member elected by the entire city. A public hearing on the proposed district maps and proposed election sequence for each council district is scheduled for Oct. 26, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. in the Weingart Ballroom at The Centre, 5000 Clark Ave. The proposed maps and proposed election sequence for each council district are scheduled to be posted online by Oct. 19 at [www.lakewoodcity.org/DistrictElections](http://www.lakewoodcity.org/DistrictElections).

Then, on Nov. 9, 2021 at 5:30 p.m., a public hearing is scheduled for a City Council meeting where a city ordinance will be introduced together with an accompanying resolution selecting a final map and establishing district boundaries and an election sequence for each council district. The hearing and council meeting will be held in the Weingart Ballroom at The Centre. The final adoption of the ordinance and resolution is scheduled for a public hearing at a City Council meeting on Nov. 16, 2021 at 7:30 p.m., also in the Weingart Ballroom.
