SUBJECT: Acceptance of Notice of Completion – Public Works Contract No. 2012-03

The Centre Skylight Replacement Project

INTRODUCTION

Harwood Construction, the Contractor on Public Works Contract No. 2012-03, has completed the replacement of the lobby skylight a The Centre at Sycamore Plaza. Staff recommends acceptance of the project, and filing of the Notice of Completion on this contract.

STATEMENT OF FACT

On August 28, 2012, the Council awarded Public Works Contract No. 2012-03 to Harwood Construction, in the amount of \$37,000 for replacement of the lobby skylight at The Centre at Sycamore Plaza. The skylight replacement occurred over only 2 days in January - the majority of the contract period was for shop drawings approval and fabrication of the skylight panels. The January installation dates were booked months in advance so as not to impact Centre clients. The project was successfully completed on time and on budget. General Funds were used for this replacement improvement, and no change orders were issued on the contract. The skylight that was replaced was original to the building's 1984 construction. Natural lighting in the lobby has been greatly enhanced by the new panels, replacing panels that had become yellowed with age.

A balance of approximately \$3,000 remains in the project account, which will be returned to fund balance of The Centre Refurbishment account.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council:

Accept the work performed by Harwood Construction, in a final contract amount (1) of \$37,000, and authorize the City Clerk to file the Notice of Completion for Public Works Contract No. 2012-03.

SUBJECT: Approval of Amendments to Agreements for Construction Phase Services

Bloomfield Park Renovation Project

INTRODUCTION

Additional architectural and geotechnical testing and inspection services are necessary to complete the renovations to Bloomfield Park.

STATEMENT OF FACT

In July 2012, the City Council awarded a Public Works Contract for the renovation of Bloomfield Park, and authorized an amendment to the agreement for construction phase architectural consulting services with Meyer & Associates. By approving the project budget appropriation, council also authorized staff to hire a geotechnical engineer for the construction phase of the project as well.

In September, 2012, Meyer & Associates' agreement was further amended to include a small amount of design work associated with the group picnic shelter, when the shelter was added into the contract by change order at that time. The extra design work was completed, but additional architectural work was created by the change in shelter type that resulted in grading and concrete design revisions. Staff requests an amendment in the amount of \$5,000 to cover this additional scope of work.

Adding the shelter back into the contract also increased the scope of work for the soils engineer, AESCO Technologies. Their original agreement was under \$10,000 and approved by Mayor as part of the project budget. Their original proposal included a scope of \$5,400 if the shelter was added back into the contract. Staff requests an amendment in this amount to cover additional construction materials testing and inspection services associated with the picnic shelter. There are adequate funds in the capital project account to cover the cost of these amendments.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council:

1) Approve the Amendments to the existing Agreements for Architectural and Geotechnical Services for the Bloomfield Park Renovation Project, with Meyer and Associates and AESCO Technologies, in the amounts not to exceed \$5,000 and \$5,400 respectively, and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign the Amendments in a form approved by the City Attorney.

SUBJECT: Encroachment Permit – 5901 Bellflower Boulevard

INTRODUCTION

Allen Davis, property owner of 5901 Bellflower Boulevard, contacted the City to obtain information regarding installation of a fence and gate around the front and side of his property. After notification that the fence, gate and columns encroach into the public right-of-way, he submitted a letter to the Public Works Department requesting an encroachment permit.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The homeowner is proposing to install a brick and wooden fence adjacent to the sidewalk on both sides of his property. The footing, fence and columns will encroach two to six inches into the public right-of-way on the east and south side of the property, and up to six feet at the southeast corner of the lot. Additionally, an existing brick planter near the front door is within the public right-of-way. Typically, the property line of a corner lot follows the radius of the sidewalk and street; however, a section of the front yard near the southeast corner of the lot, about ninety square feet, is within the public right-of-way. The neighborhood consists of single-family and multi-family homes between South Street and Allington Street and commercial development on the northwest corner of Bellflower Boulevard and South Street. The requestor's home is at the entrance to the tract on the corner of Bellflower Boulevard West Service Road and Andy Street. Pedestrian public right-of-way adjacent to this lot consists of a disabled person pedestrian ramp at the corner, one foot six inch wide curb and gutter on both sides of the property, thirteen foot wide sidewalk/parkway on Andy Street, and twelve foot wide sidewalk/parkway on Bellflower Boulevard West Service Road. The proposed fence and gate will not exceed forty-two inches in height eliminating the need for planning approval or building permit, and the existing brick planter is within the front yard. The location and height of the fence should not pose a problem to pedestrians. The owner's letter requesting an encroachment permit is attached as well as a map showing the location.

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council approves the encroachment permit for property located at 5901 Bellflower Boulevard, authorize the Mayor to sign, and direct the City Clerk to record it with the County Recorder.

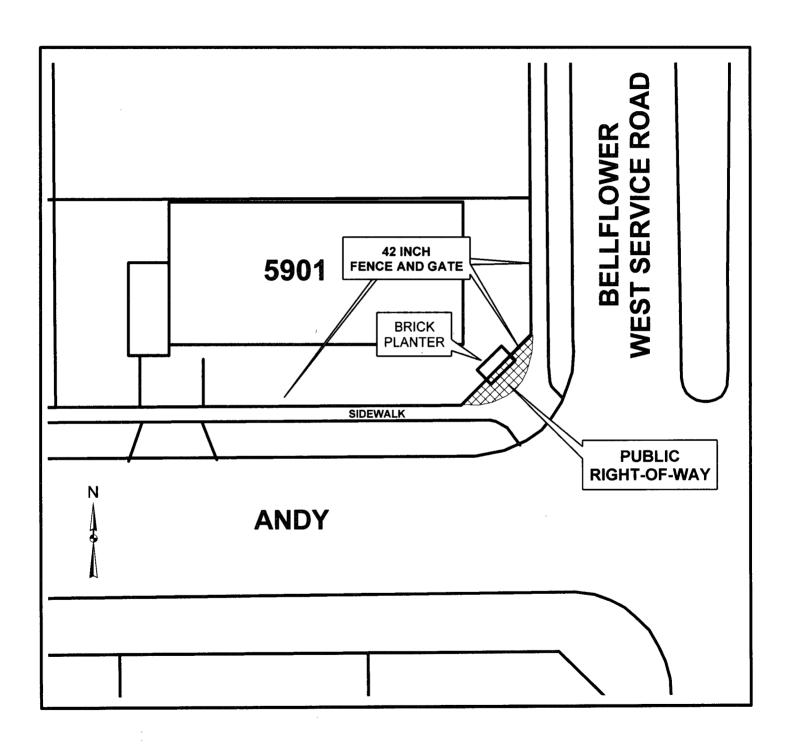

INTRODUCTION

The Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) is a set of the City's financial statements that complies with the generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP) promulgated by the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB). The City of Lakewood's CAFR is compiled by the Administrative Services Department staff and audited by an external American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) certified accounting firm White Nelson Diehl Evans LLP, utilizing FASB requirements.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The City of Lakewood's Fiscal Year 2012 CAFR is composed in the standard format of four sections: Introductory, Financial, Supplementary Schedules and Statistical.

- The Introductory Section includes the Transmittal Letter to the City Council from the City Manager and the Director of Administrative Services, the City's organizational chart and certificates of achievement.
- The Financial Section includes the Independent Auditor's Report, staff's Management's Discussion and Analysis which provides a review of the year-over-year changes from the Fiscal Year 2011 CAFR, the Basic Financial Statements of the Governmental and Business Type Activities of the City, and the Fund, Proprietary and Fiduciary Financial Statements, followed by the Notes to the Basic Financial Statements.
- The Supplemental Schedules section includes schedules of the City's various special revenue funds (grants), and internal service and fiduciary funds.
- The Statistical Section contains information on the financial trends, revenue and debt capacity, demographic and economic data and operational information of the City.

GASB Statement 54 went into effect in Fiscal Year 2011, and the objective of this Statement is to enhance the usefulness of fund balance information by providing clearer fund balance classifications that can be more consistently applied across all governmental agencies. The fund balance classifications establish a hierarchy of available fund balance amounts based on the constraints imposed on the City in using these funds. This Statement provides for the classifications of nonspendable, restricted, committed, assigned, and unassigned based on the relative strength of the constraints that control how specific fund balance amounts can be spent.

- The initial classification distinction identifies amounts that are considered *nonspendable*, such as fund balance associated with inventories.
- The *restricted* fund balance category includes amounts that can be spent only for the specific purposes stipulated by constitution, external resource providers, or through enabling legislation.
- The *committed* fund balance classification includes amounts that can be used only for the specific purposes determined by a formal action of the City Council.
- Amounts in the assigned fund balance classification are intended to be used by the City for specific purposes but do not meet the criteria to be classified as restricted or committed.

GENERAL FUND SUMMARY

The 2012 fiscal year General Fund revenues were boosted by the increase in the exchange of Prop A funds of \$571,960, and a year-over-year bounce in sales tax of \$443,045. Franchise fees and business licenses also showed a year-over-year gains of \$119,005, as well as gas taxes by \$115,759. These increases were offset by the loss of motor vehicle license fees of \$341,663, and declines in building and safety permits and fees of \$285,895, utility users tax on communications of \$129,795, property leases of \$152,658, and parking enforcement citations of \$80,308. Other on-going revenues on a year-over-year comparison were relatively flat.

For revenues that are not ongoing or reoccurring, the dissolution of the Lakewood Redevelopment Agency had the greatest impact on General Fund revenues. General Fund revenues posted a year-over-year \$351,019 decline in LRA reimbursements and an \$861,264 decline in LRA interest payments. These payments fall to zero in Fiscal Year 2013, a loss of \$4,961,575 in revenue for the General Fund when compared to Fiscal Year 2011.

Year over year change in General Fund expenses showed an increase in operational expense of \$364,172; this is almost entirely due to the dissolution of the redevelopment agency and the obligation placed on the city to absorb redevelopment support costs.

In general terms, the City remains in sound fiscal condition. The fund balance as now presented per GASB 54 shows that all the City's long-term obligations are manageable with multi-year capital projects fully funded, pension obligations met, and is no outstanding General Fund debt.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the City Council receive and file the City of Lakewood Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) Year Ended June 30, 2012.
