MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER at 7:30 p.m. by Vice Mayor Pe in the Council Chambers at the Civic Center, 5000 Clark Avenue, Lakewood, California.

Vice Mayor Pe announced that later in the meeting, a resolution declaring an end to the state of a local emergency related to the coronavirus pandemic, which started in March 2020, would be presented by the City Manager. The Vice Mayor stated that 186 Lakewood residents had died from COVID-19 over the past three years and that the meeting would be adjourned in their memory.

Council Member Rogers stated for the record that Mayor Croft's absence, due to his attendance at an out of town conference, was excused.

Council Member Wood commended staff on a successful Lakewood Youth Hall of Fame event. He further acknowledged staff for their efforts in providing residents with information regarding gas bill assistance and suggested sharing information with residents on the upcoming Southern California Gas Company rate hearing.
